Math's—Holly Class

In Year 4 Math's, we learnt how to find the area of shapes. Area is the space inside a closed shape and is measured in square units such as cm², m², or km². We start by counting



the squares inside shapes, then use length × width to calculate the area when the squares are not shown. For example, this shape has 16 squares, or $4 \times 4 = 16$ cm².

Class News—Silver Birch

In Silver Birch, we have been writing our own cinquain poems about the war. We had a visit from Mrs Macey to consolidate our learning on Everest survival and exploration. In music we have been writing song



lyrics to create our own 12 days of 'South Hill'. Finally, this week we have started our learning on fractions.
