Maths Corner— Y4

Time is an essential part of our everyday lives and in Year 4 we will be learning about conversion of time between the **12 and 24 hour clock** with a focus on how 24 hour time is read. In military time, for example, 6:00 p.m. or 18:00 is referred to as "eighteen hundred hours." So, we will be learning that 18:00 is thought of as 18 hours after midnight and most appropriately expressed as **6 pm**.



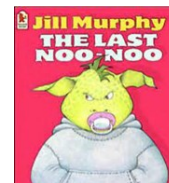
When converting between hours, minutes and seconds, we use our knowledge of multiples of 6 and 60 to support our understanding. We also count in 7s (days in the week) and 12s (months in the year) to help our understanding of conversion. Why not have a go at the following: Does zero appear more frequently in the 12 hour or 24 hour clock? Or, A play starts at 19:25 and finishes at 21:05. How long does the play last?
