



#### Yearly overview

An overview of what your child will be learning about in each subject in their new year group. This is useful to look at for opportunities to support and extend their learning outside the classroom. You could visit the local library and borrow some books on the topics covered, look at the topic together on the internet or even plan a local trip.

## **Knowledge organisers**

In most subjects, we use Knowledge Organisers to detail what key knowledge your child will be taught and that we want them to retain. These are stuck into pupil books at the start of a new topic and referred to throughout, as we build knowledge over time. Included is subject specific key vocabulary which is essential to each topic.





## **Transition Booklet**

Our child friendly transition books are designed to help pupils know all of the practical information they need to know when changing year groups or starting a new class, such as information about their classroom, PE days, School trips and shows.

The Year group pages also contain some specific Year group information, such as the phonics screening in Year 1 or the multiplication times tables check in Year 4. They also contain **recommended reading lists**, **tricky spelling word lists** and **VIPERS reading question sets**. We hope you find this information useful in supporting your child on their learning journey and we ask that you spend time navigating these pages with your child in order to further their knowledge and understanding of our curriculum.
