#### Half Term Pop-up Clinics for MMR Vaccinations

Pop-up vaccination clinics have been arranged over half term to make it easier for you to make sure your child is fully vaccinated against measles mumps and rubella and any other



childhood vaccinations they may have missed. People of all ages can attend the clinics, including young people and adults. Measles can make your child seriously unwell and one in five children end up in hospital because of complications. Measles spreads very easily, especially in schools. A child with measles will infect almost all unprotected children they have contact with as they can catch it just by spending time in the same room. Vaccination is the best protection against measles, and it is vitally important to make sure your children have had both of their free MMR vaccinations.
