Behaviour Principles

Rationale and Purpose

This written statement of 'Behaviour Principles,' is reviewed and approved by the Full governing board annually. It is in line with the Department for Education (DfE) and in line with the school's Behaviour Policy.

- We believe all pupils, staff and members of the school community should uphold and maintain our school values of 'The South Hill Way;' reflect, responsibility, resilience and respect (the 4Rs).
- All pupils, staff, parents and visitors have the right to feel safe (in both body and mind), valued and respected as part of South Hill's school community.
- All pupils, staff, parents and visitors are free from any form of discrimination.
- Pupils learn positive behaviours through a therapeutic approach which is everybody's responsibility to model.
- South Hill school work in partnership with pupils, parents and staff to support positive behaviour.
- Pupils are helped to take responsibility for their actions.
- Families are involved in behaviour incidents to foster good relationships between the school and pupils' home life.
- The governing board also emphasises that malicious or threatening behaviour from pupils, staff, parents and visitors will not be tolerated in any circumstances.
