



### South Hill School Travel Plan

At South Hill we are committed to developing a safe and sustainable journey to school for all of our children. We are currently working in conjunction with Modeshift stars and Herts County Council to achieve a Bronze accreditation for our Travel Plan.

In order to achieve this we are working on a range of areas linked to travelling to and from school these include:

- Bike ability – where our children learn how to cycle safely around the school and local roads.
- Road safety: Including how to cross roads safely, staying safe when walking on pavements, staying safe when travelling to school and finding safe places to cross roads.
- Walk to School week – encouraging children and adults to walk, scoot or cycle to school and leave the car at home.
- A lollipop crossing.

We also have some other education initiatives due to take place later in the year including:

- Road safety for EYFS
- Road safety for year 1
- Scooter proficiency for Year 2

We are also investigating ways to make drop off and pick up safer for our children both within school and outside the school gates.



In order to achieve our ModeShift Stars Bronze Accreditation our next steps are:

- To carry out a pupil survey about how they travel to school.
- A staff survey about traveling to and from school.
- Workshops for Year groups stated above.
- Other initiatives to promote safe journeys to school.
