Beech—Grammar corner

This week in Beech we have been looking at recounts in English. We explored what pronouns are and how to use them to avoid repetition of a noun. A pronoun is a word that substitutes a noun. For example,



'Harry picked up the pirate hat and Harry put the pirate hat on' repeats the nouns 'Harry' and 'pirate hat'. 'Harry picked up the pirate hat and he put it on' is less repetitive and uses the pronouns 'he and it'.

Silver Birch—Class News

Silver Birch have been using their angle finders to identify acute angles (smaller than a right angle), obtuse angles (bigger than a right angle) and right angles.

GOSH Fundraising


Mrs. Cummins, who has joined our office team, will be running the London Marathon at the end of April. She will be raising funds for Great Ormond Street Hospital. If you
