#### **Grammar Corner—Silver Birch**

In Silver Birch we have been learning about explanation texts. A feature of explanation texts is the use of modal verbs. Modal verbs show possibility, intent, ability, or necessity. The most frequently used ones



are: can, may, might, could, should, would, will, and must. As they are a type of <u>auxiliary verb</u> (helper verb), they are used alongside the main verb in a sentence. For example: My baby brother **should be** asleep by now. Or judging by the clouds, it **might rain** today.

We have learnt to identify and understand the use of modal verbs. Next week we will be using them in writing our own explanation texts
