Class News - Silver Birch

Silver Birch have settled in well into the new roles and expectations of Year 5. We have had a busy few weeks, learning about the Vikings in different areas of the curriculum. In History we have learnt about progression from the Anglo-Saxon



era to the Viking takeover, beginning with the battle of Lindisfarne. The children wrote amazing news reports covering all the key facts on the battle and using careful emotive language to hook the audience. The theme of the Vikings continues into our guided reading sessions. We are reading the 'Viking Boy', this is giving us a real insight into the brutality of the battles of the time from a young boy's perspective. In Art we are learning about drawing using lines, tone and shading. This week we sketched a shoe in detail, using all three techniques to create a 3D sketch and we will be using these skills to create a sketch of a dragon's eye in line with our Viking theme.

Grammar Corner—Owls

In year 2 this week we have been looking at conjunctions.

A conjunction is a word that connects phrases or clauses together. These include and, because, when, so, and but. We



have been looking at these in our English lessons but recognise conjunctions are used across our curriculum and in speech.
