## **Class News - Goldfinches**



We have had a great week of learning in Goldfinches. We started the week with practising our songs and dances for the Christmas show and we even tried our camel and angel costumes on. In English,

we read 'The Snowman' by Raymond Briggs and by the end of the week, we sequenced the story focusing on what happened at the beginning, middle and end of the story. We 📥 focused on our grammar of time adverbials (first, next, finally) and using the conjunction



'and' in our writing to join our ideas together in a sentence.

In Geography this week, we have been learning about human and physical geography. We learnt that human geography is something that has been built by humans such as a school or a house, compared with physical geography, which is about natural features, for example, oceans, mountains and rivers.

#### Grammar Corner—Holly

This week in Holly we have been looking at personification to expand our descriptions of the events of Pompeii in our diary entries. Personification is where you give an inanimate object the features or actions of a



person or animal. 'The lava ran quickly down the side of the volcano.' 'Large rumbles shook the Earth with fury'. The use of personification in our diary entry enhances our setting description and allows us to demonstrate what the people of Pompeii experienced during this time.

Our author of the month is Tom Fletcher. Tom has written over 20 children's books including The Creakers and There's a Monster in Your Book. In 2017 Tom wrote The Christmasaurus, CHRISTINGALIBUS which is a story about a boy named William

Trundle and а dinosaur named the Christmasaurus. It's about how they meet one Christmas Eve and have a magical adventure. It includes friendship and families, sleigh bells and Santa, singing elves and flying reindeer. Also discovering your heart's true desire, and learning that the impossible might just be possible . . . Tom has since added to his range of Christmasaurus adventures so as we approach Christmas it is a great time to try one of Tom's books.
