

- Autumn 2 = Learning Focus 'How can we improve learning across the school?'



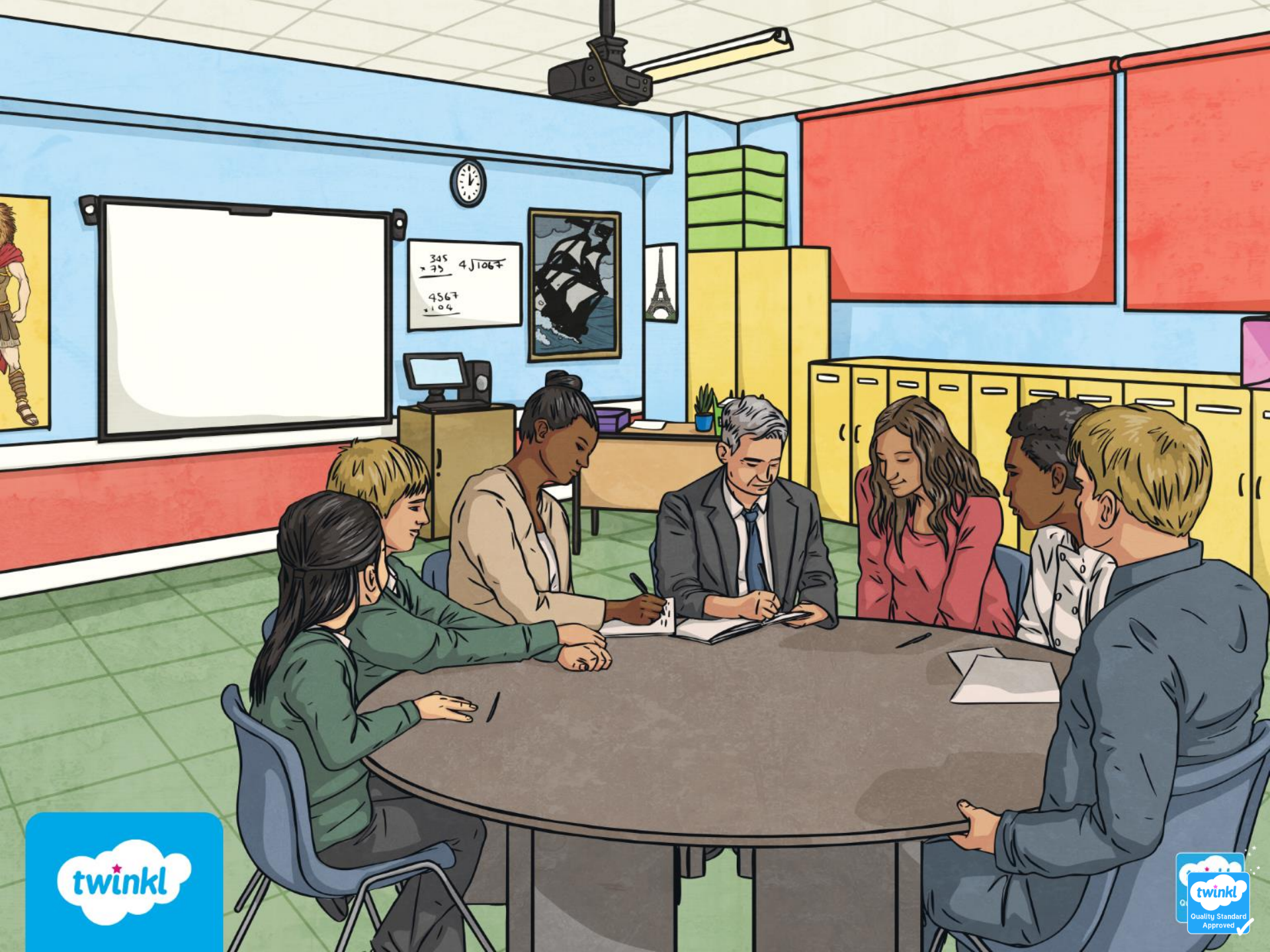
