

Math's Corner

This regular newsletter feature highlights a key part of our math's curriculum: the CPA approach (Concrete, Pictorial, Abstract). Children first explore concepts using



concrete materials (e.g. base 10, bead strings), then move to pictorial representations, and finally to abstract methods (e.g. 3 + 6 = 9). This approach is used from EYFS to Year 6, with daily *Fluency Fitness* sessions helping reinforce learning and build lasting understanding.

Math's Corner—Owls Class

This term in Year 2, we're focusing on place value, using Base 10 equipment to explore tens and ones in two-digit numbers. The children have enjoyed hands-on games to reinforce these concepts. Later this week, they'll use part-part-whole models and work with 1p and 10p coins to deepen their understanding. Through playful and



practical activities, we're building a strong foundation in number sense to support future math's success.
