Grammar Corner—Oak

In our English lessons, we have been revising sentences. There are four different types of sentences: statements, commands, questions and exclamations. Each type of sentence does a different job. Statements usually end



with a full stop but can also use an exclamation mark. Example-The dog is barking. Commands usually have an imperative (bossy) verb and may have an exclamation mark at the end. Example- Stop that dog from barking! Questions must end with a question mark. Is that dog barking? **Exclamations** must end with an exclamation mark. What a huge dog that is!
