#### **Grammar Corner—Silver Birch**

Silver Birch have been using shape-coding (represented by shape or colour) to look at different types of fronted adverbials. These are types of sentence openers (they could be words or phrases) that traditionally answer questions (such as the one in the shape below) and are followed by a comma to separate it from the main clause. Here is an example of a sentence using fronted

adverbial. After boiling the water in your cauldron, add three pinches of thinly chopped rabbit tail.
